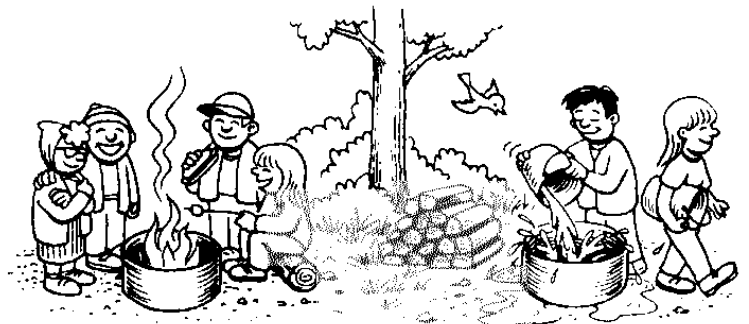
Camping & Day Use

- Enjoy your stay up to a maximum of 14 consecutive days
- Do not build long term structures
- Return your site to its natural condition before leaving
- Competitive, commercial or group use requires permission
- Pay camping and other service fees to recreation site operator if applicable



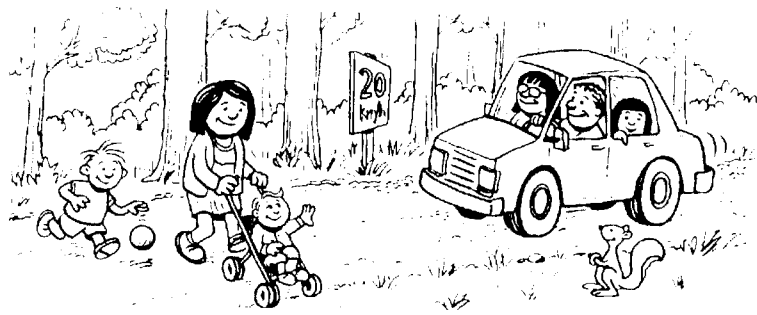
Campfires

- Keep your campfires small and in the fire rings
- Do not light campfires during strong winds
- Do not cut trees or remove firewood
- Attend your campfire at all times, extinguish before you leave



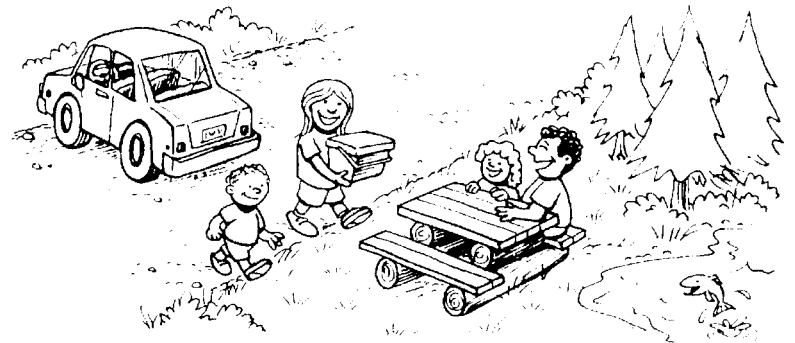
Drive Cautiously

- Roads are often used by visitors as paths and play areas
- Maximum speed is 20 km/h
- Do not drive over the vegetation
- Always wear your bike helmet when riding your bike



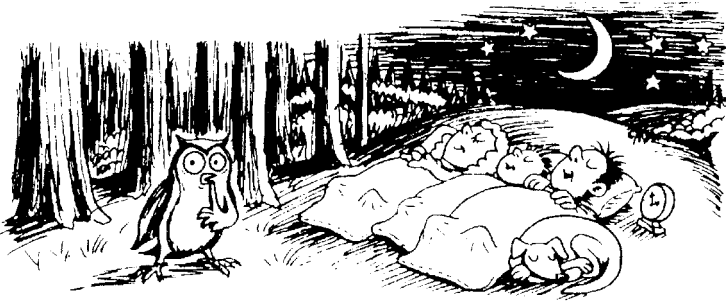
Parking

- Park in designated areas
- Keep roads clear, do not block traffic



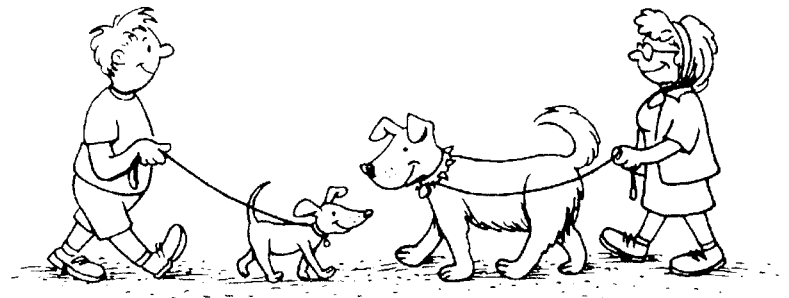
Courtesy

- Respect the peace and quiet of others
- Keep your noise to a minimum at all times
- Obey designated quiet time: 11pm to 7am



Pets

- Keep your pets quiet and under control at all times



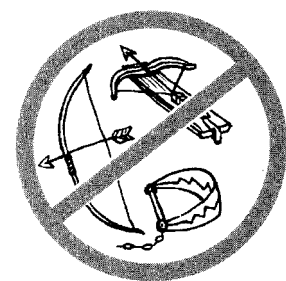
Garbage
